Cristina Cárdenas focuses her practice on international litigation and arbitration. Her experience includes the representation of U.S. and Latin American corporate clients in a variety of business related disputes, including disputes involving distributorship, manufacturing and other commercial agreements.

Recent results achieved include successfully serving as co-counsel to a Latin American licensee that was awarded \$52.6 Million as well as attorneys' fees in an international arbitration against a major shoe manufacturer in a licensing dispute arising out of the Mercosur region, as well as successfully enforcing a multi-million dollar arbitration award that had been rendered in Colombia on behalf of a Colombian telecommunications company. *Mercury Telco Group, Inc., v.
